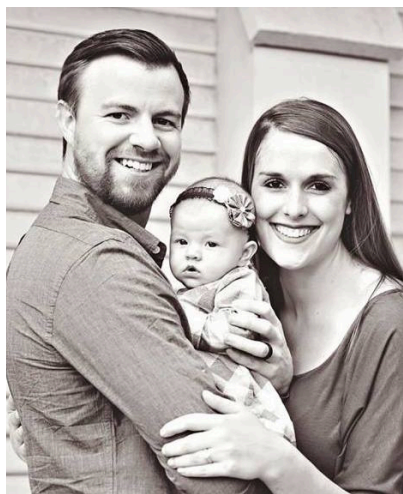
Pastors

Details of Duties and Responsibilities:

- Lead a bible study class of students on Wednesday nights
 - You will be provided curriculum for the classroom activity
 - You are asked to read the material and prepare for the lesson
 - The classroom session is about 17 minutes long

- You will guide your class through every rotation including music and rec to be there to help make transitions smooth while you build relationships with your group.

- Lead a bible study class of students on Wednesday nights
 - You will be provided curriculum to look over during the week
- You will guide students through every rotation building relationships with your group. We need four male **at least** leaders and four female leaders.

Commitments:

- Meet every Wednesday from 5:55 to 7:15
 - ❖ Spend time praying for the students and reading through the weekly lesson (Time est: 30 outside of Wednesday Scheduling.
 - ❖ Contact Cody if interested in helping for this spring semester; volunteer's are needed.

Summary of Position:

- Activities are for both guys and gals.
- Grades range from 6th-12th
